



2026 Baseball, Softball & Tee-Ball Q&A

Why Youngsville Recreational Sports Programs?

Our goal is to provide quality recreational programs for the growth and development of our city's youth. We want to develop parks and recreation for the city of Youngsville, into a great organization, that meets and exceeds the citizens' expectations.

Where do I register?

When do I register?

Registration for Residents exclusively on Monday, December 15th and Monday, December 22nd for everyone. Registration ends on Friday, January 16th. *Some leagues may fill up before registration ends based on our player limits.*

What are the age determining dates for tee-ball, baseball, and softball leagues?

Boys – Your age on or before April 30th, 2026
Girls – Your age on or before August 31st, 2025

Are there any sports that are co-ed?

The only league that is co-ed is 3-4 year old Tee-Ball.



What are the age groups?

Our youth sports will be available for children, ages 3 through 14.

Do I have to live in Youngsville in order to play baseball, softball, or tee-ball?

No. Anyone meeting the age requirements is eligible for league play, no matter where they reside. For All-Star play, see next question.

If I do not live in Youngsville, will I be eligible for PONY Baseball/Softball/Tee-Ball All-Stars?

- Boys who reside in Lafayette Parish ARE eligible for All-Stars.
- Boys who live OUTSIDE of Lafayette Parish, in an area where PONY Baseball is NOT offered for their age group, ARE eligible for All-Stars.
- Boys who live OUTSIDE of Lafayette Parish, in an area where PONY Baseball IS offered for their age group, ARE NOT eligible for All-Stars.
- Girls of all ages are eligible for league play and All-Star play no matter where they reside.

What is the cost of registration?

The cost of registration is \$85.00 per player for the 3-4 Tee-Ball League and is \$115.00 per player for all other leagues.

Is there a family discount?

Yes. There is a sibling discount of \$25.00 per child, after the first child. The cost with the sibling discount will be \$90.00 per child.

Example: Three siblings registering to play: \$115 for the first sibling, \$90 for second sibling, \$90 for third sibling.



Is there a late registration fee?

Yes. There will be a \$20.00 late fee after January 23rd
ONLY IF space remains available in the desired league.

What does registration include? What do I need to buy?

Registration includes the player's jersey and cap. Players are responsible for pants, belts, socks and shoes (tennis shoes or rubber cleats).

Which age groups play tee-ball, coach pitch, and live pitch?

Tee-Ball (3-4 Years Old)

- Players bat from a tee
- League is co-ed (boys and girls)

Shetland Boys & Shetland Girls (5-6 Years Old)

- Players bat from a tee
- Separate boys and girls leagues

Pinto Boys & Pinto Girls (7 & 8 Years Old)

- Players bat against the coach's pitch
- Separate boys and girls leagues

Mustang Boys & Mustang Girls (9 & 10 Years Old)

- Players bat against live pitching
- Separate boys and girls leagues

Bronco Boys & Bronco Girls (11 & 12 Years Old)

- Players bat against live pitching
- Separate boys and girls leagues

Pony Boys & Pony Girls (13 & 14 Years Old)

- Players bat against live pitching
- Separate boys and girls leagues



When are practices?

Practices will begin on the week of March 16th. Teams will have 1-2 practices per week, between Monday and Friday. Day of practices will be scheduled after drafts have been completed and can change week to week.

When will games start and end?

Baseball/Softball opening day will be Saturday, April 11th. Games will begin on Monday, April 13th. The last regular season game is scheduled for Friday, May 15th. Rainout games will be played the following week.

When will the games be played?

Games will be played Monday through Friday. Each team will have one-two games per week. Schedules will be made after drafts have been completed.

What affiliation will your Baseball/Softball league be?

YSC is affiliated with PONY Baseball/Softball for all rules, regulations, and All-Stars.

Can my child play in a league outside of the appropriate age group?

- Any players wishing to move outside of their appropriate age group require prior approval from YSC.
 - Players are NOT allowed to play in a league below their designated age group.
 - Players are NOT allowed to move from Tee-Ball to Shetland, or from Shetland to Pinto.
 - Players ARE allowed to move from Pinto to Mustang, Mustang to Bronco, or Bronco to Pony.

How long is my commitment for All-Stars?

How are All-Stars selected?

Area high school baseball coaches will conduct the All-Star tryouts independently and provide YSC with recommendations as to who should be named to the All-Star teams. League coaches will not be involved in the independent tryouts.

League coaches will complete a ballot that will include their recommended All-Star teams in their league. League coach's ballots will help provide support for players who are not able to attend the tryouts or may have a bad day at the tryouts. League coach's ballots and independent tryout ballots will be compiled by YSC, and final All-Star teams will be selected by YSC.
